

Par 3 Safety Guidelines

- We are unable to offer hire clubs at the moment so please ensure ALL players have their own personal equipment to use. This includes clubs and golf balls (remember to bring spares)
- There will be a separate queueing system for the Par 3 so please see signs for details and remember to stay 2 meters apart whilst waiting.
- Under the new government rules the following golf groups will be permitted on the Par 3:
 1. Individuals playing golf on their own.
 2. Maximum four-balls comprising of individuals from different households.
 3. Members of the same household playing in a four-ball maximum.
- Groups will be a maximum of 4 players.
- You must wait until the players in front have left the green before teeing off.
- Players will be limited to 6 holes per game, once you have played 6 holes you must re enter the queue at the range if you wish to play again.
- Do not congregate at any point on the course.
- Bunker rakes have been removed.
- The flag sticks will remain in the hole but do not touch or remove them.
- Hole cups will be turned upside down so the ball will not fall below the green surface.
- You must stay at least 2 meters apart at all times
- Do not touch stray balls or any lost property.
- Make your best effort to smooth out sand bunkers using your club or feet. You are welcome to use your own folding rakes.
- Only play to the green when it is clear and remember not to touch the flag stick.
- If you would like any assistance whilst on the course please call the pro shop or clubhouse, we are still available for first aid, marshalling and security queries.
- These restrictions are in place for your safety and the safety of others. They are policies set out by England Golf and the government so must be followed with no exceptions. We will operate a zero-tolerance approach for anyone not following them and you will be asked to leave immediately.
